Town of Aurora to install Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations

The Town of Aurora will be installing two publicly-accessible Electric Vehicle (EV) charging stations later this year. One charging station will be located at Aurora Town Hall and the other at the Aurora Community Centre.

EV drivers will be able to 'fill-up' their vehicles at these stations, free of charge, for a one-year introductory period. After the first year, a pay-per-use fee will be in effect.

This project is part of a larger initiative to promote EV technology in Aurora and help the Town become one of Ontario's most EV-friendly communities. Aurorabased Magna E-Car Systems already makes components for many of the EVs on the road today.

Over the past several months, The Town of Aurora staff have been working diligently to schedule and deliver over 150 business visitations across Aurora, as part of the Business Retention & Expansion initiative.

Businesses were selected to participate based on location, number of full-time employees and industry. The response from the business community has been positive with most businesses willing to meet with staff and complete the survey.

Staff have also personally followed up with businesses on every 'red flag' issue that was identified and provided relevant information regarding business support services.

Staff are pleased to report that the last few interviews to reach the target sample size have been completed, and are currently completing final follow-ups and preparing to tabulate results in order to identify and analyze trends.

Staff will share the results of the survey with all participants as part of developing an action plan to address the concerns of the local business community.
